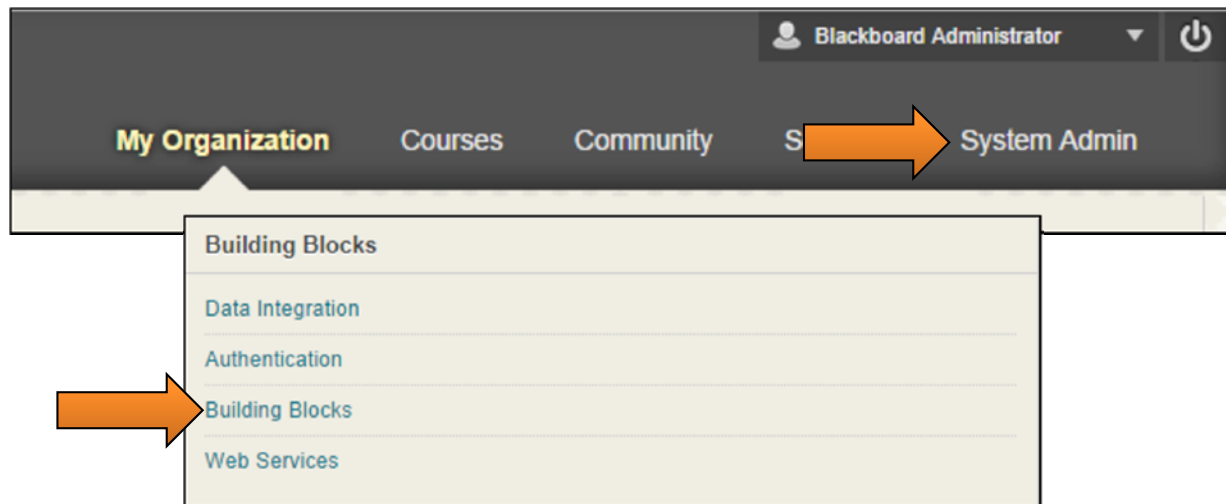


This tutorial assumes you have administrative rights to Blackboard and you have access to the Ensemble Video Building Block for Version 3.7 and above. You can download the building block Package at <http://ensemblevideo.com/downloads/blackboard/ensemblebuildingblock.war>.

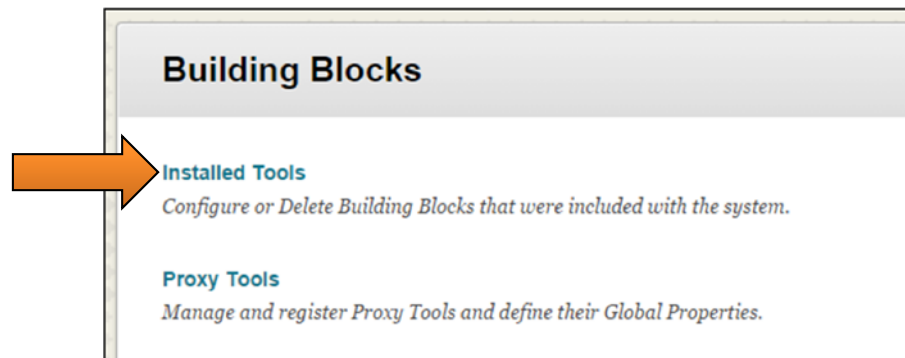
Login with your administrator account.



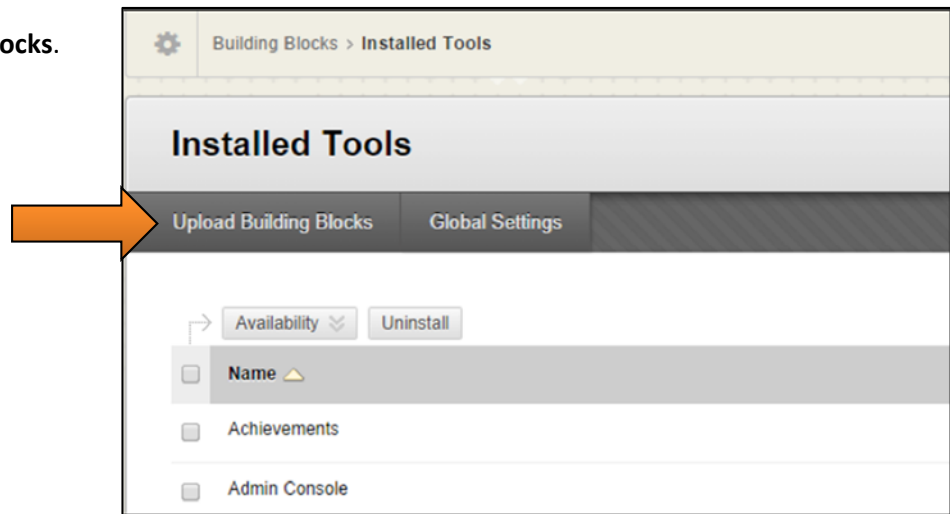
Go to the **System Admin** section, then go to the **Building Blocks** section and click on 'Building Blocks'.



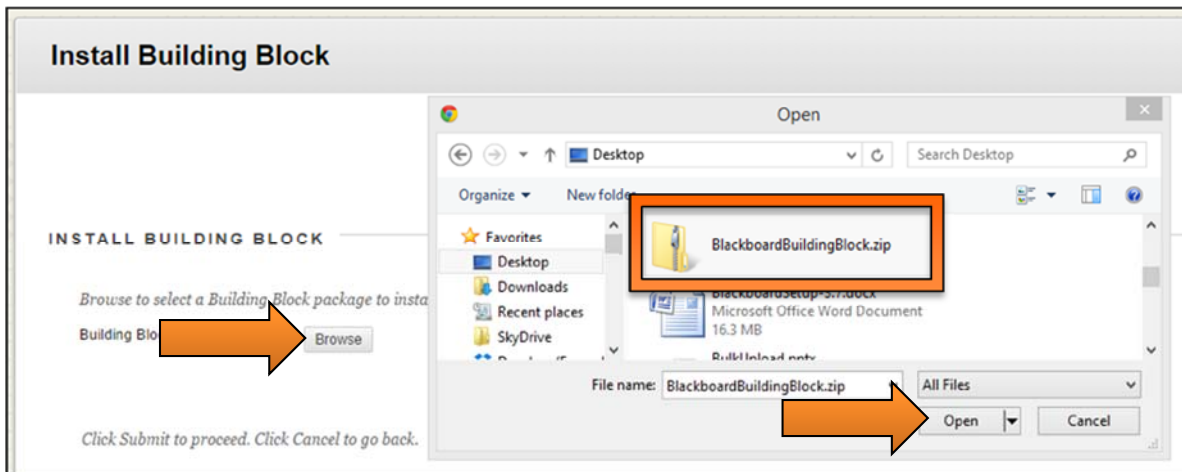
Go to **Installed Tools**.



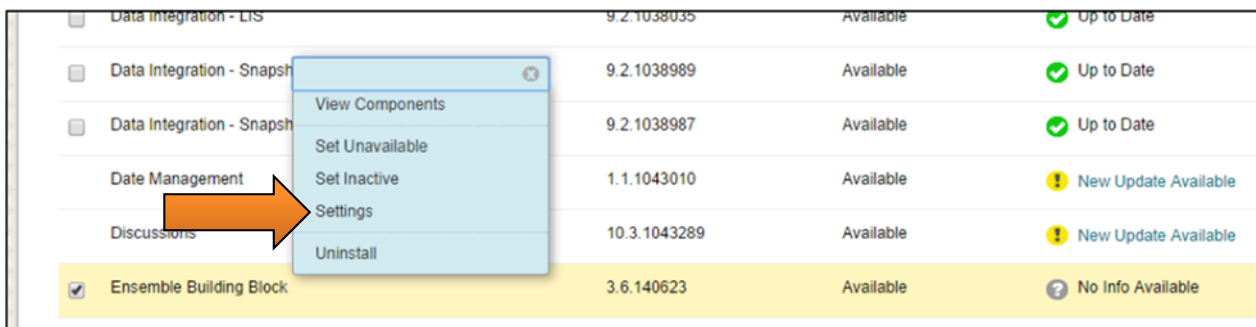
Click on **Upload Building Blocks**.




Click **Browse**, select the building block .zip file, and click **Open**. Next click **Submit** to upload and install the building block.



Find **Ensemble Building Block** in the list. Click on the down arrow next to the entry and select **Settings**.



NOTE: By default the building block is set to **'Available'**. To disable the block system-wide, you can use the menu and select **Set Unavailable** or **Set Inactive**. Tool availability can be set per course if it needs to be configured at the course level.

Configure the building block settings and click **Submit**.

Server URL: The Ensemble Video server URL.

- **LTI Consumer Key:** A key obtained from the Ensemble Video application.
- **LTI Shared Secret:** The secret key paired with the consumer key. Also obtained from the Ensemble Video application.
- **Key Ensemble Users By:** Select the property which will link the Blackboard user to an Ensemble Video user.
- **Optional Domain:** Your top level domain if you are using an Identity Provider in Ensemble Video.

You have successfully configured the Ensemble Video building block.

Users who have accounts in Blackboard and Ensemble Video that match will have direct access to add media to their course by using the content plugins or the mashup tool.
